IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE

Parents must transport all medication to the school clinic. It is the parents' responsibility to provide medication for students with life threatening allergies and other chronic health problems. Prescription medication will be administered to students in the clinic when accompanied by written instructions from the parent. THE MEDICINE MUST BE IN THE PRESCRIPTION BOTTLE WITH THE STUDENT'S NAME ON THE LABEL. A permission to administer form must be completed by the parent.

NON-PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION WILL BE ADMINISTERED TO STUDENTS IN THE CLINIC ONLY WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY WRITTEN INSTRUCTION FROM THE PARENT/ GUARDIAN. The instructions must include the name of the student, name of the medication and purpose, dosage and directions. A parent signature is required along with the date.
