NURSING NOTES

Welcome to Skiles Test Elementary School! I am your School Nurse, Nurse Beatriz Castro. This will be my 2nd year as Skiles Test nurse. The ST clinic hours are Monday-Friday, from 7:00AM-3 PM.

My goal is to keep your child and all of the other students here at Skiles Test safe, healthy, and happy every day! In order to do that, I will need you to fill out the Medical Information and the Consent to Treat form online on skyward. The medical information page provides me with important health information about your child so that I may care for his/her individual needs. The Consent to Treat gives me permission to care for your child in the clinic. Without a consent to treat signed by a parent or guardian, I am unable to treat your child in the clinic on a daily basis. I will only be able to care for your child in emergency situations.

Parents of kindergarten and 6th grade students, please turn in a copy of your child's vaccination records to the school nurse as soon as possible. You have until October 5th if vaccines not up to date after this day child will not be able to attend school.
