NURSING NOTES

September is Immunization Compliance Month
in the clinic!

Students in Kindergarten & all other grades are
required to have the following vaccinations in
order to be admitted into Skiles Test Elementary
School:

- 5 Dtap (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)
- 4 IPV/OPV (Polio)
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 2 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- 2 Varicella (Chicken Pox)
- 2 Hepatitis A vaccinations

For Kids in Preschool

- 4 Dtap (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)
- 3 IPV/OPV (Polio)
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 1 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox)

6th grade students are required to have the
Tdap, MCV (Meningococcal), and 2 Hep A vac-
cinations.

New students to the district and/or school must
turn in a copy of his/her vaccination records to
the clinic. Parents choosing to not vaccinate
their children must request a religious or medical
exemption form. Students who are not appropri-
ately vaccinated will be excluded from school
beginning October 18th, 2019. If you have any
questions about vaccinations, please contact
Nurse Beatriz.
